Interactive Media Design (IMD) provides students with an expansive understanding of the processes and methods involved in conceiving, creating, and evaluating technology-mediated experiences. IMD students create media products ranging from video and immersive artworks to web-based and platform-specific apps. IMD enables students to develop creative solutions to complex problems. The two-year curriculum, blends academic theory, human-centered design, artistic technique, process management approaches, and methods for gathering and analyzing critical metrics.
